**AGREEMENT about Quality of Services
between
IO-Link Consortium
and
IOL-Competence Center (IOL-CC)**

1 General

1.1 Purpose of this agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to establish a quality assurance system between IO-Link consortium and the IOL-Competence Centers (IOL-CC) for the technologies of IO-Link.

1.2 IOL- CC

- A) An IOL-CC is an active member of the IO-Link consortium and must fulfill the following criteria:
- Fulfillment and acceptance of the Quality of Services Agreement for IOL-CC
 - Positive accreditation report of two independent IOL-experts. One of the experts and the IOL-CC candidate have to meet personally, the other one may judge from written notice. In some instances, when a IOL-CC candidate is known to the experts, a personal visit may not be necessary. This should be decided by the two experts.
- B) The IOL-CC is available by e-mail, phone, fax and letter during fixed times on working days. It is the responsibility of the IOL-CC to inform the IO-Link consortium about its correct address. The preferred method of communication is e-mail.
- C) Shall install, run, and maintains a demo system of IO-Link products from different vendors. It is recommended that the demo system contains at least 5 devices from 5 different manufacturers. A monitor tool should also be part of the demo system.
- D) Replies to technical enquiries about IO-Link.

1.3 Accreditation of IOL-CC

The IOL-CC candidate sends a Request to IOL-experts. The status now is "IOL-CC in foundation" . After a positive result of the IOL-experts report the IOL-CC candidate is confirmed. The accreditation expires after 2 years. After this period a re-accreditation can be applied.

Accreditation will be withdrawn if the IOL-CC fails to meet the criteria for an IOL-CC or loses the support the IO-link consortium.

1.4 Re-Accreditation

The accreditation is valid for two years. After this period, the IOL-CC applies for reaccreditation. The re-accreditation needs to be supported by the IO-Link consortium and is confirmed by the IO-Link SC.
